## INTRODUCING JACK - 18 MONTHS OLD

Medical issues, sibling transplants, long hospital stays, floods and family separation due to exhaustive medical treatments... this little family has endured a lot over the past 18-months. Soon after Jack was born his lung collapsed, requiring urgent treatment to support his breathing. But as testing continued it was identified that Jack would require a bone marrow transplant to help manage his complex diagnosis. His big sister, Bethany, is a marrow match, and as she prepared for her role as full-time superhero as Jack's donor. The Baxter's live in Forbes, 370km from Westmead, a 14hr return trip from Westmead Kids Hospital. For the last 18 Months, Jack has attended monthly medical appointments. Since September 2022, 19 months old Jack Baxter and Mum Emma Baxter have stayed at the Ronald McDonald house, while they prepared to undergo a bone marrow transplant just before Christmas, to save Jack's life.

The Baxter family was dealt another heart breaking situation in November 2022, with the Forbes floods. The flood washed away all the Baxter's possessions and caused serious damage to their farm and livelihood. Little Wings has been there for the Baxter's organising their transport, working alongside Ronald McDonald Charity House to remove the financial stress, travel times and accommodation costs. This safety net, has allowed the family to focus on the sick child and provide some peace of mind during this difficult time dealing with Jack's medical condition, rebuilding their home and lively hoods.
