Strongman Troy Conley-Magnusson will be pulling a Return and Earn truck full of bottles and cans, with the weight of this truck equivalent to that of 1,000,000 cans and bottles; that is approximately 14 tonnes of recycled units.

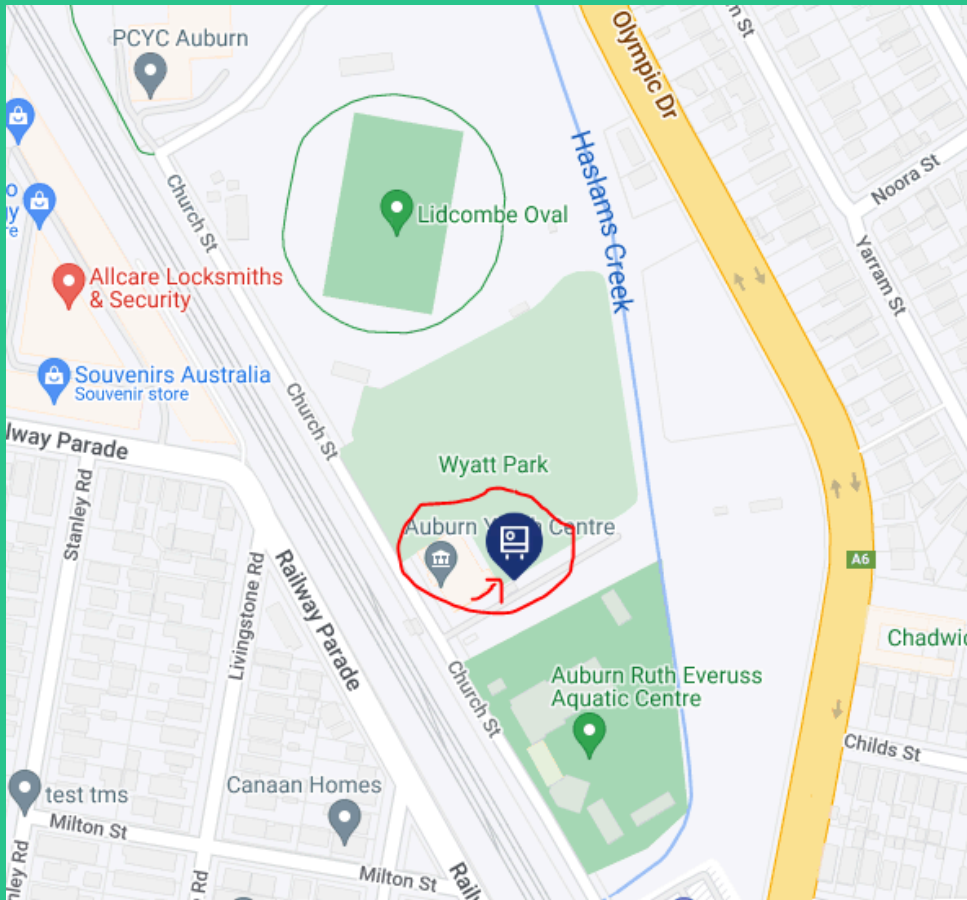
