WHAT WE PROPOSE

Our objective is to gather qualified drink containers that can be redeemed for a 10c refund under NSW's Return And Earn container deposit scheme. This initiative provides an excellent opportunity for the community groups, businesses and schools to participate in recycling, diminish litter and generate funds for Little Wings Australia.

HOW IT WORKS

Step 1. You kindly agree to participate in the fundraiser. Register online now.

Step 2. Little Wings provides 2 or more recycling bins on the starting launch date.

Step 3. When the bins are full, contact the local Return And Depot to collect the bottles and cans. Pick up scheduled can be organised.

Step 4. The Return And Earn Depot recycles the units and processes the donation.

Step 5. Little Wings will notify the club of the donation contribution via text or email.

Special Note: If there is not a Return And Earn Depot in your area, please take your containers to the local Return And Earn machine, download the return and earn app, select Little Wings as your charity, scan the app at the machine and start recycling.



WHAT WE WILL PROVIDE

1. You will receive 2 FREE branded Little Wings recycling bins.

2. Little Wings will visit you to celebrate the launch of the fundraiser. Little Wings will create professional social media content, tag and share your kindness to the world.

3. Every donation, a Little Wings staff member will contact you with donation amount.

4. Little Wings will send an Annual Impact Report highlighting your contribution.

GOOD TO GO: MOST DRINK BOTTLES AND CANS





These containers are most commonly found as litter in NSW. They're often consumed 'on the go.' *Cans (e.g. soft drinks) *Bottles (e.g. beer bottles) *Cartons *Juice boxes or poppers

Most containers between 150ml and 3 litres are accepted and can get you a refund. However, they must... *Be in good condition (not be crushed or broken) *Be empty

*Have the label attached

NO GO: ITEMS THAT ARE NOT REFUNDABLE



These items aren't accepted, but can still go into household recycling. They're often used at home.

*Plain milk bottles or cartons *Flavoured milk containers of 1L or more *Glass wine bottles *Glass spirit bottles *Cordial bottles *Pure juice containers 1 litre and over (comprising of at least 90% pure juice)

INTRODUCING JESSE JONES

Flying with Little Wings since he was 6 months old, Jesse is now 5 years old and thriving.

Jesse, a Tamworth local. This family have been travelling with Little Wings long term but they recently found themselves to be frequent fliers, completing 6-missions in 6-weeks and with little reprieve ahead. Jesse was born with cystic fibrosis, a condition that affects the lungs, pancreas, liver and kidneys. Jesse has always been treated by the team at John Hunter Children's Hospital in Newcastle, but when his condition worsened over Christmas, he was transferred to Westmead Children's Hospital. This has seen an increase his time spent away from home and the frequency of medical intervention escalate to weekly... placing the entire family unit under immense pressure.
